

ACSP Development strategy for 2017-2020

ACSP – is an NGO serving as diverse corporate security experts unification platform.

Participants (members): professional members of the market having expert knowledge's demonstrated by success in career, business or public appreciation.

Planned membership till 2020 (incl): 150-200 people.

Access: free, not less than 2 references from ACSP members, be decision of the Board

ACSP aims for the period:

1. Active promotion of corporate security industry in business community
2. Legislative activities
3. Corporate security market structuring among participants of spheres of corporate security, physical security, Security departments, cybersecurity etc.
4. To build up relations with governmental security with the aim of recognition of corporate (private) security as integral part of Ukraine national security system.
5. Setting up long-term relation with renown international organizations working in the sphere of corporate security.

These aims should be reached by:

1. Promotion of corporate security sphere:
 - Conducting 1-2 conferences per year by ACSP along with other relevant NGO's.
 - Conducting 2 seminars per year on specific activities in sphere of corporates security. For example, corporate intelligence, cybersecurity, TOP-management protection, owner's family security etc.
 - Conducting round tables in relation to specific ACSP's initiatives or its members e.g. Draft Law on Private military companies.
 - Interview and press-conferences of ACSP members.
 - ACSP's support of conferences and events upon request of ACSP's member or external partner request.

2. Legislative activities are aimed on development and further forwarding to people's deputies and further support of following draft laws:
 - On civil arms and ammo circulation
 - On private military companies
 - On commercial secret and confidential information
 - On corporate (private) security services of legal entities of non-governmental sector
 - Other draft laws upon initiative of ACSP participants or external partners
3. Structuring of corporate (private) security market:
 - Joint activities with specialized NGO's at corporate security market to support ACSP aims and tasks in frames of general strategy of specialized professions development
 - Creation of Committees within ACSP on specific activities
 - Joint work with educational establishments on training and creation of professions in sphere of corporate security
 - Development, implementation and promotion of corporate security standards in business community
4. Building up relations with state authorities:
 - Access to Public councils of relevant ministries and institutions.
 - Work with committees of Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.
 - Invitation of recognized experts in the field of National Security, corporate security, state agencies of interior and institutions of Justice
 - Conducting joint state-agencies of interior public events
 - Drafting joint state-agencies of interior documents in the sphere of National and corporate (private) security their support and further implementation

ACSP officials responsible for strategy implementation:

1. Board. Chairman of the Board
2. Executive Director



3. Committees Chairmen.
4. Coordinators of specific directions

1. ACSP budget
2. Charity fees of ACSP members or external partners
3. Funds available from sponsors and partners of public events
